Looking Local Blockchain Use Case Suitability Checker

What does my result mean?
The higher the score, the more appropriate for blockchain is your use case.

If your use case scores **lower than 30%** then it is not suitable for blockchain. There is not enough benefit for multiple parties to work together, or there is not agreement between multiple parties on what rules and requirements around processes and data could be shared to make a service or process better.

Use cases **scoring 30-50%** might be suitable for blockchain, but issues around how and why multiple parties might work together around the data and the process need to be clarified.

If the use case **scored between 50 – 70%** then it has a reasonably strong business case and probably achieves some added value. If the service or process is important for achieving organisational efficiencies or customer value, then a proof of concept should be considered. If it is mission critical, it should not be considered for proof of concept, as there are still levels of uncertainty around the business case.

If the use case **scores above 70%**, it is suitable for blockchain, with a strong business case and at least some proof that value can be added for customers and organisations. Developing a proof of concept should definitely be considered.

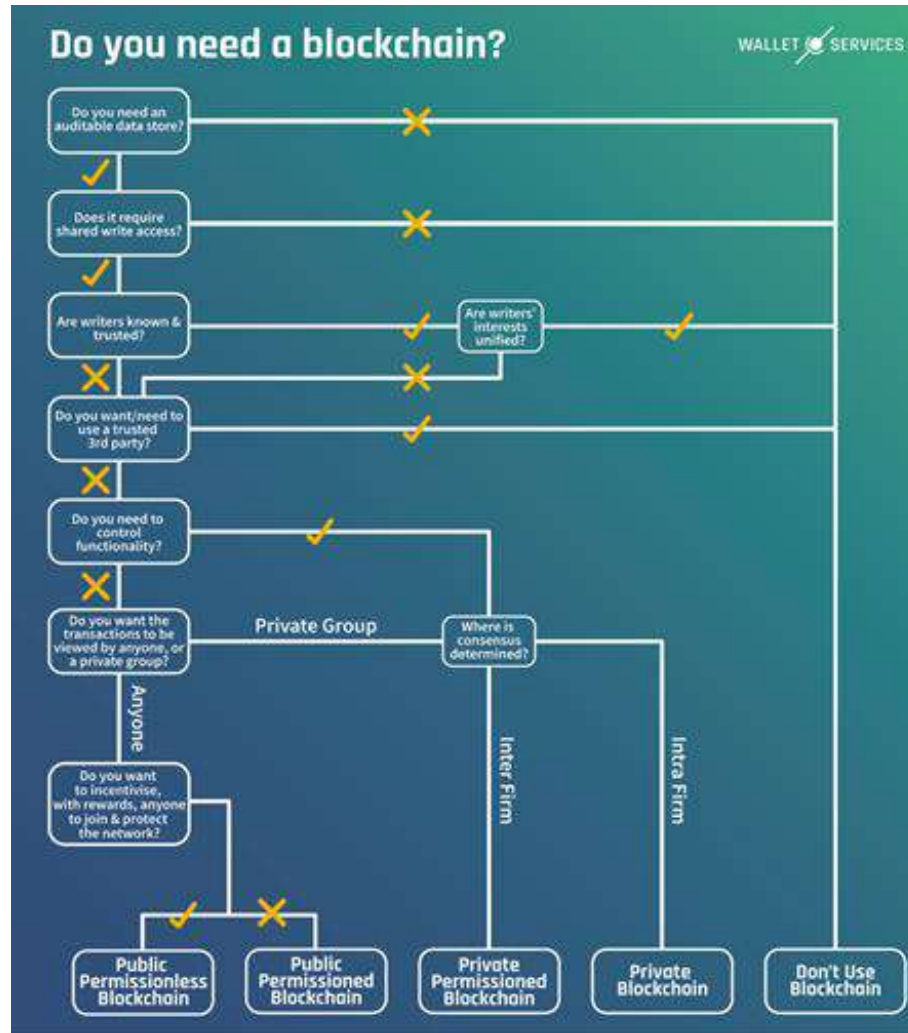
